### M.O.V.E.

*(Mobility Opportunities via Education/Experience)* is a transformative activity-based program designed to help individuals acquire the motor skills needed for sitting, standing, walking and transitioning. The program helps individuals who use a wheelchair to become more independent and self-reliant. We are the only agency to offer M.O.V.E. in the NYC Metro area.

### About CP Unlimited:

The long history of the Agency is paralleled with the development of Staten Island as a leading community for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD). The organization was founded in 1946 on the island by a group of concerned parents of children with Cerebral Palsy who advocated for needed supports and services.

Today, the organization supports hundreds of people across Staten Island while employing many dozens of borough residents in our network.



### Smile Farms

Through our partnership with Smile Farms, the Agency supports two full-time employees and a rotating community of Day Hab participants to help plant, harvest, and distribute the crops from our on-site greenhouses.
