Paul DiGiovanni, Associate Director of Rehabilitation Services, recently shared a story about a woman trapped in her home for *three years* due to a lack of a working wheelchair, access to transportation, and clinical services such as adaptive equipment.

Our wheelchair grant from the Mother Cabrini Foundation allowed us to provide these needed services and have our team arrange transportation to get an appropriate wheelchair for her!

He also got to see a father of two take delivery of a power seat lift for his motorized chair after much advocacy and work by Danielle King OTR/L. Dad exclaimed "Now I can go shopping on my own and reach a box of rice on store shelves!"
