About the Clinics:

Ongoing Sessions
Advancing Mobility



CP Unlimited's sustaining series of Wheelchair Clinics are complimentary, community-based sessions that offer cleaning, sanitizing, and maintenance services for motorized and non-motorized wheelchairs and their users, including people with disabilities, seniors, and veterans.

Many people who use wheelchairs are dependent on their chair for mobility, so eating, drinking, negotiating transport, and everything else is done while sitting in the chair. This can lead to wear and tear, the accumulation of debris, and the loss of certain functionalities.

The services offered include fixing and repairing chair features, replacing pads and coverings, sanitizing surfaces, power washing (for non-motorized chairs), and, in some cases, replacing or upgrading wheelchairs altogether.
